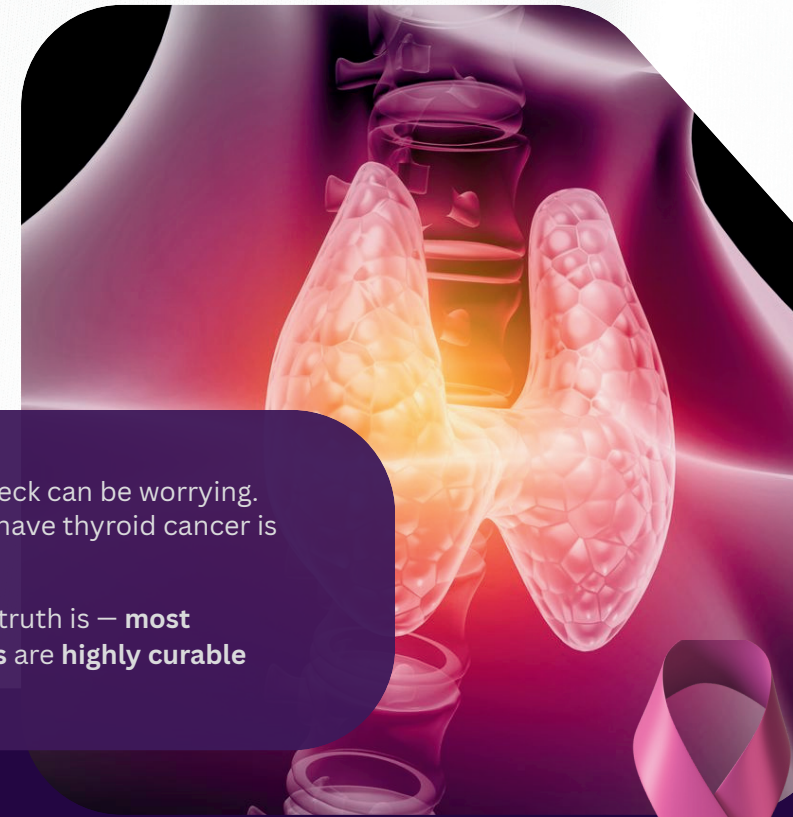

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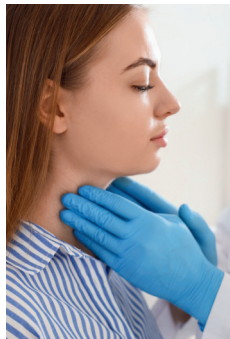
# How common is thyroid cancer?







Thyroid cancer is one of the **most commonly** diagnosed cancers, often seen between **25 - 55 years of age**

The most common types **grow slowly** & respond well to treatment if patients are **diagnosed early**, often during routine scans or health checks

# How is this cancer diagnosed?



Doctor may suggest:

-  A neck ultrasound to look at the thyroid
-  A simple needle test to examine the lump cells (FNAC)
-  Blood tests to check thyroid function
-  These tests are safe, quick, & accurate.

Most thyroid cancers

- **Grow slowly**
- **Remain limited** to the thyroid for a long time even when nearby lymph nodes are involved

 Treatment success remains very high in expert hands.

# Treatment options



**Surgery** is the main treatment for thyroid cancer. Depending on the case, part or all of the thyroid may be removed.

Thyroid surgery today is :

01. Well-established
02. Highly precise
03. Safest with experienced surgeons

 Most patients **recover quickly** & are discharged within a few days.

Radioiodine therapy and medicines :

Some patients may need **radioactive iodine therapy after surgery**. This treatment safely **destroys** any **remaining thyroid cells**. It **does not affect other organs**.

If the entire thyroid is removed, a daily tablet replaces the thyroid hormone. This tablet is **safe, well tolerated**, and taken **once a day**.

**Regular follow-up** ensures the dose is always right for you. With **proper treatment** and follow-up, recurrence is uncommon and usually treatable.
